THIRD ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On January 27, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission entered its order approving the stipulation and agreement in this case which stated, *inter alia*, that Kansas City Power & Light should file on a prospective basis a copy of the quarterly reports required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.070(5). The reports are due each year on April 1, July 1, October 1, and January 1.

KCPL filed a notice of filing on November 5, 2001. Attached to the notice as Schedule A, KCPL included a copy of the quarterly decommissioning trust fund report for the period ending September 30, 2001. Thus, a quarterly report covering the period ending December 31, 2001, is now due.

KCPL will be directed to file the quarterly report in compliance with the Commission's order. KCPL is also urged to comply more fully with the Commission's orders in the future.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Kansas City Power & Light Company must, no later than March 15, 2002, file with the Missouri Public Service Commission its quarterly report as required by the order approving stipulation and agreement issued on January 27, 2000.

2. That this order will become effective on March 11, 2002.


