## ORDER GRANTING LATE FILING OF AFFIDAVITS AND INTERVENTION

On May 11, 2000, NeuStar Inc., requested leave to file out of time the affidavit of Sandra L. Tokarek, for the testimony of Ms. Tokarek which was stamp-filed on May 11, 2000. On May 17, 2000, GTE Midwest Incorporated filed the affidavit of John C. Rollins, for the testimony of Mr. Rollins that was filed on May 10, 2000. The requests to late-file the affidavits were served on the parties of record. No objections have been received.

On May 10, 2000, Southwestern Bell Wireless Inc., (SWBW), filed its Application to Intervene and Request for Leave to File Application to Intervene out of Time. SWBW states that it inadvertently missed the intervention due date as a result of changes in SWBW's legal and regulatory representation in the State of Missouri. SWBW states that granting intervention will be in the public interest because its interest is different from that of the general public; it will bring its expertise and experience as a wireless telecommunications provider to this case; and no other party will adequately represent its interest. No objections to this late intervention have been filed.

The Commission finds that the requests to late-file affidavits and the late-filed application to intervene may be granted.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. That the request by NeuStar, Inc., to late-file the affidavit of Sandra L. Tokarek is granted.
- 2. That the request by GTE Midwest Incorporated to late-file the affidavit of John C. Rollins is granted.
- 3. That Southwestern Bell Wireless Inc., is granted intervention in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075, and the Commission's Records Department shall add its counsel to the service list in this case: Kenneth L. Judd, 13075 Manchester Road, 100N, St. Louis, Missouri 63131.
  - 4. That this order shall be effective on June 2, 2000.
