ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On April 4, 2000, the Public Service Commission issued its Report and Order in this matter. On April 7, 2000, Spectra Communications Group LLC (Spectra) filed its Motion for Correction of Report and Order. In its motion, Spectra contends that the Commission erred, on page 20, by referring to Spectra as a "foreign corporation." Spectra is, as the Report and Order states on page 6, a Delaware limited liability company. Spectra urges the Commission to correct the Report and Order.

The Commission is not convinced that it erred by describing a Delaware limited liability company as a "foreign corporation." Spectra must support its motion with suggestions, including citations to appropriate authorities in support of its contention; or the same shall be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Spectra Communications Group LLC shall file suggestions as described herein in support of its Motion for Correction of Report and Order on or before 3:00 p.m. on April 21, 2000.
2. That this order shall become effective on April 20, 2000.
