ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On December 9, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of convenience and necessity to Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. (Central Rivers), authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area (Fox Run Subdivision) of Clay County, Missouri. In that order, the Commission directed Central Rivers to file, within 30 days of the effective date of that order, tariff sheets consistent with the order describing the terms and conditions under which it would provide sewer service.

On February 2, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing which indicated that the Commission had not received the tariff filing. The Commission directed Central Rivers to file a status report advising the Commission of when it expected to file the tariff sheets.

On February 10, 2000, Central Rivers filed the proposed tariff sheets. The tariff sheets bore an effective date of March 15, 2000,

which was extended to March 24, 2000. Central Rivers filed revisions on March 7, 2000.

On March 8, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum stating that it had reviewed the tariff sheets and was of the opinion that they were in compliance with the Commission's Order Granting Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheets, as filed on February 10, 2000, with the March 7, 2000, revisions.

The Commission has reviewed the revised tariff sheets and finds that the tariff sheets, as amended on March 7, 2000, conform to the Commission order of December 9, 1999, and should be approved to become effective on March 24, 2000.

For purposes of administrative efficiency, the Commission will close this case. However, Staff may still file the results of the rate review in this case even though it is closed. Other than Staff's rate review filing, no further activity will take place in this case, and it may now be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following revised tariff sheets (Tariff File No. 200000724}, filed by Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc., on February 10, 2000, with revisions filed on March 7, 2000, are approved to become effective on March 24, 2000:

Revised Sheet No. 4, Canceling Original Sheet No. 4
Revised Sheet No. 9, Canceling Original Sheet No. 9

2. That this order shall become effective on March 24, 2000.
3. That this case may be closed on March 25, 2000.
