ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO EXPEDITE CONSIDERATION OF TARIFF

On October 15, 1999, Kingdom Telephone Company d/b/a Kingdom Long Distance (Kingdom) submitted a tariff designed to add service descriptions and rates for toll directory assistance, which were inadvertently omitted from the original tariff filing. As the tariff is currently written, Kingdom will not be able to bill its customers and recover its costs for toll directory assistance. Kingdom will begin providing the service on October 20, and requests that the Commission expedite its consideration of the tariff. Kingdom states good cause for such treatment as required by 4 CSR 240-2.065(2).

In order that the Commission may consider Kingdom's tariff expeditiously, the Staff of the Public Service Commission will be directed to expedite the filing of its recommendations regarding Kingdom's tariff. The Commission will not direct Staff to file its recommendation by a certain date, but will instead direct Staff to file its recommendation as soon as possible.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall expedite its consideration of the tariff of Kingdom Telephone Company, d/b/a Kingdom Long Distance (Tariff File No. 200000371) and shall file its recommendations regarding that tariff as soon as possible.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on November 1, 1999.
