ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION

On April 27, 2000, OnSite Access Local, LLC (OnSite), filed its application for a certificate of service authority to provide resold and facilities-based intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services. On June 5, 2000, OnSite filed a Motion for Leave to Amend Application. The motion notes that in paragraph 14 of its application, OnSite requested that the Commission waive certain statutes and rules of the Commission, including Section 392.290.1, RSMo 1994. OnSite now seeks leave to amend paragraph 14 by interlineation to request a waiver of not only paragraph 1 of Section 392.290, but the entire section.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(21), "[a]ny pleading may be amended within ten (10) days of filing, unless a responsive pleading has already been filed, or at any time by leave of the commission." OnSite's request to amend its application was filed more than 10 days after its application.

However, the Commission will grant OnSite leave to amend its application as requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Motion for Leave to Amend Application filed on June 5,
 2000, by OnSite Access Local, LLC, is granted.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on June 30, 2000.


