ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On March 9, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed and its motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of authority and accompanying tariff of Itelecom. Itelecom was originally granted a certificate of service authority by the Commission to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services on January 6, 1995, in case number TA-95-36.

In support of its motion, Staff states that Itelecom did not file an annual report for 1998, and the company's 1999 annual report form was returned by the post office as undeliverable. Staff further states that it was informed by the Missouri Secretary of State's Office that Itelcom was administratively dissolved on August 31, 1995, due to its failure to file an annual report. Staff argues that Itelcom has violated the terms of its certificate by its failure to keep the Commission informed of its current address and telephone number and by its failure to file annual reports as required by law.

Staff states that the Commission has authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation's certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo Supp. 1999:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

Staff's motion includes a certificate of service that recites that a copy of the motion was mailed or hand-delivered, on March 9, 2000, to Itelecom's president at an address in Riverdale, New York, and to Itelcom's attorneys in Washington, DC. The file includes no indication as to whether or not any copy was ever received, or whether any copy was returned by the post office as undeliverable. The Commission concludes that the record does not show that sufficient notice has been given to Itelecom to permit the Commission to exercise its authority under Section 392.410.5, RSMo Supp. 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall give notice of its Motion to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Accompanying Tariff by mailing a copy thereof to Itelecom, and its attorneys of record by certified United States Mail, return receipt requested, and shall file its pleading in this case advising the Commission whether the same was delivered or was returned. The Staff shall further advise Itelecom in its cover letter that Commission rules require that a response be filed within ten days.

2. That this order shall become effective on June 5, 2000.
