ORDER REQUIRING FILING

On June 18, 2000, Coast International, Inc. (Coast) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) its application for an extension of time to file its annual report which it also filed the same day. Coast requested that the Commission "...authorize an extension of time sufficient to allow the attached Annual Report of Coast International, Inc. to be filed contemporaneous with the filing of this application..."

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(1), "[a]ll public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year¹."

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(8) states, in part: "A utility which is unable to meet the filing date [of April 15]...shall make a written request to extend the filing date for its annual report...and state the reason for the extension request." Coast did not comply with

¹ April 15, 2000, was on a Saturday, thus effectively making the due date the following Monday, i.e., April 17, 2000.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(8) in that its application did not state a reason why it could not file its annual report until June 18, 2000.

The Commission will require Coast to file a supplemental pleading which includes an explanation why it could not file its annual report pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(8) until June 18, 2000.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(3) states, in part: "Each pleading shall include a...specific reference to the statutory provision or other authority under which relief is requested." Coast's application did not comply with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(3) in that it did not include a specific reference to the statutory provision or other authority under which relief was requested.

The Commission will require Coast to file a supplemental pleading which includes a specific reference to the statutory provision or other authority under which relief was requested pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(3).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Coast International, Inc. shall file, no later than 3:00 p.m. on July 13, 2000, a supplemental pleading which includes an explanation why it could not file its annual report pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(8) until June 18, 2000, and also which includes a specific reference to the statutory provision or other authority under which it requested relief.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 3, 2000.
