ORDER APPROVING INTERIM NEELYVILLE DISTRICT RATES

United Cities Gas Company (United) of Franklin, Tennessee, submitted a tariff sheet to the Commission on February 29, 2000, carrying an effective date of April 1, 2000. The tariff sheet is designed to reflect changes in Neelyville District's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as a result of an increase in the spot market gas cost and the termination of a refund factor. The effect of these changes will increase the Neelyville District PGA Factor from \$0.2502 per Ccf to \$0.2911 per Ccf.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum stating that the change in United's PGA was calculated in conformance with its approved PGA Clause and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective on April 1, 2000. Staff recommended that the tariff sheet submitted in this filing be approved, interim subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in Case Nos. GR-99-280 and GR-2000-392.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet, Staff's recommendation, and finds that the tariff sheet conforms to the Company's Commission approved PGA Clause and is therefore reasonable. After considering Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date, April 1, 2000, interim subject to refund.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:



That the tariff sheet submitted on February 29, 2000, by United Cities Gas Company of Franklin, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for natural gas in its Neelyville District, be, and it is, hereby approved to become effective on and after April 1, 2000, interim subject to refund. 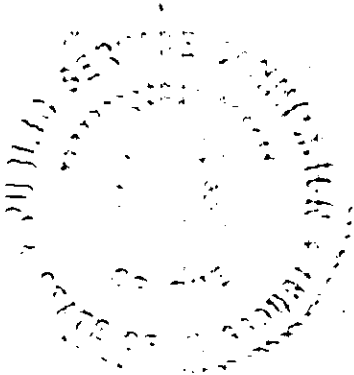
