ORDER REQUIRING FILING OF FIRST AMENDED APPLICATION

On April 28, 2000, J D Services, Inc. (J D Services or Applicant), a Nevada Corporation, filed an application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, requesting competitive status, and requesting waiver of certain statutes and rules. J D Services states that it merging with a Utah corporation that uses a similar name and has concurrently filed an Application for Merger Approval.

The Commission notes that this application is styled with a d/b/a name. If the Applicant intends to use a fictitious name in Missouri it must provide evidence that that name is registered to it in Missouri. Applicant should supplement or amend its application to clarify its intent and provide an explanation of whether additional information supporting the use of a fictitious name will be provided and under what circumstances.

The application is not compliant with current rules and requirements of the Commission. Under 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K) J D Services is required to inform the Commission of certain pending



actions or judgements. Under 4 CSR 240-2,060(L) J D Services is required to inform the Commission whether it has assessment fees or annual reports due the Commission. The application does not cite specific statutory authority under which the application is filed per 4 CSR 240-2.060(6), e.g. Section 392.440, RSMo. The application is not double spaced as required by 4 CSR 240 2.080(14). There is no certificate of service incorporated or attached with the application as required by 4 CSR 240-2.080(19).

Finally, the Commission notes that the requested statute and rule waivers that are stated in the application do not reflect current rule numbering or standard waivers. The Applicant is encouraged to review its requested waivers with the Commission's Staff to determine if its request is appropriate to its circumstances.

Because the application presents several deficiencies or matters requiring clarification, J D Services will be ordered to file a First Amended Application that addresses the deficiencies and matters requiring clarification as noted herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That J D Services, Inc., a Nevada corporation, shall file, no later than 3:00 p.m. on May 22, 2000, a First Amended Application to resolve the matters described in this order.

2. That this order shall become effective on May 15, 2000.
