# ORDER SETTING A PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 23, 2000, the Commission issued an order directing Stone County Emergency Services, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and the Office of the Public Counsel to file a response to GTE Midwest Incorporated's (GTE) request for mediation of the complaint filed by Stone County Emergency Services against SWBT and GTE. On July 7, SWBT filed a notice indicating that it would accept GTE's offer of mediation. However, on July 10, Stone County Emergency Services filed a pleading indicating that it would not consent to mediation. As not all parties have agreed to mediation, this case will proceed as a formal contested case.

So that this case may proceed expeditiously, the parties will be directed to file a proposed procedural schedule. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and for a hearing. To

assist in the development of the procedural schedule and to clarify the issues in dispute, an early prehearing conference will be scheduled.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That an early prehearing conference shall be held on August 2, 2000, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The prehearing conference shall be held at the Commission's offices on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August 9, 2000. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and for a hearing.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on July 24, 2000.
