**ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE**

On February 14, 2000, Calls For Less, Inc. (CFL) filed its application for the surrender of its certificate of service authority (application), asking the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to cancel its certificate of service authority. The Commission granted CFL a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in case number TA-95-256 on May 19, 1995.

CFL stated in its application that it has no customers within the state of Missouri and that the surrender of its certificate of service authority would not be detrimental to the public interest.

Section 392.410(5) RSMo 1999 states, in part: ". . . Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected. . . ." The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public

Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no one has requested a hearing in this case, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the verified application.

On February 28, 2000, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation. Staff stated that it had no objections to CFL's request and recommended that the Commission issue an order to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service and the accompanying tariff.

The Commission has reviewed the application, Staff's recommendation, and the official file and finds that the Certificate of Service Authority granted to CFL in case number TA-95-256 shall be canceled.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the certificate of authority granted in case number TA-95-256 to Calls For Less, Inc. shall be canceled on March 24, 2000, unless otherwise ordered by the Missouri Public Service Commission.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 24, 2000.

3. That this case may be closed on March 27, 2000.
