#### ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT OUT OF TIME

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080(1), "[a]ll public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year."

On June 6, 2000, NEXTLINK Long Distance Services, Inc. (NEXTLINK) filed a Motion for Leave to File Annual Report Out of Time with the Commission requesting that its 1999 annual report be accepted for filing. NEXTLINK attempted to file the annual report on or about April 19, 2000, and the report was returned by the Commission as not being timely filed. NEXTLINK requested that the Commission grant its Motion for Leave to File Annual Report Out of Time and accept its report for filing. NEXTLINK stated that it missed the deadline for filing the annual report through honest but excusable inadvertence, which was not done intentionally or designed to purposely violate the rules of the Commission. NEXTLINK stated that allowing the late filing of the annual report would not be detrimental to the public interest. No objections to NEXTLINK's motion were received.

The Commission finds that good cause exists to permit filing of NEXTLINK's annual report out of time and the Commission will grant NEXTLINK's motion for leave.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That NEXTLINK Long Distance Services, Inc.'s Motion for Leave to File Annual Report Out of Time filed June 6, 2000, is granted, and the annual report deadline requirement of 4 CSR 240-10.080 is waived permitting the filing of NEXTLINK Long Distance Services, Inc.'s annual report.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 17, 2000.
  - 3. That this case may be closed after July 18, 2000.
