ORDER SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSE

On February 23, 2000, North Suburban Public Utility Company, Inc. (NSUCI), filed its application seeking authority to acquire 72 shares of the outstanding capital stock of Ozark Shores Water Company. Thereafter, on May 1, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing, requiring the parties to submit their status reports on or before May 30, 2000. NSUCI filed its report on May 2, 2000. Therefore, in order to move this matter promptly to resolution, the Commission will require that the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission file its status report on or before May 19, 2000.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file the status report previously ordered herein on or before May 19, 2000.

2. That this Order shall become effective on May 19, 2000.
