ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

On January 22, 1999, MCI Telecommunications Corporation (MCI),  
MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. and MCImetro Access  
Transmission Services, LLC (MCImetro) and Teleconnect Long Distance  
Services & Systems Company (Teleconnect) filed their motion to  
consolidate Case No. TO-99-260 and Case No. TO-99-290. AT&T  
Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed its application for  
variance of emergency rule 4 CSR 240-33.150 on December 8, 1998 in Case  
No. TO-99-260. MCI, MCImetro and Teleconnect filed their application  
for variance of emergency rule 4 CSR 240-33.150 on December 31 in Case  
No. TO-99-290. As both parties seek a variance of the same emergency  
rule, and no objection was received from any party, the Commission will  
grant this Motion to Consolidate Cases.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Motion to Consolidate Cases filed on January 22, 1999, by MCI Telecommunications Corporation, MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC and Teleconnect Long Distance Services & Systems Company is granted.

2. That Case No. TO-99-260 shall be the lead case and parties to Case No. TO-99-290 are hereby made parties to the consolidated case.

3. That this order shall become effective on February 23, 1999.
