May 8, 1999 - was a Saturday, the last day for response became Monday, May 10, 1999. Rule 6(a), Fed. R. Civ. Pro. On that day, SWBT filed its motion seeking an extension, up to and including May 17, 1999, within which to file its response to Sprint's petition. In particular, SWBT stated that it is unable to respond to the petition sooner because Sprint has not yet filed Exhibit B to the petition.

The Commission finds that SWBT has shown good cause and that the requested extension should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The Southwestern Bell Telephone Company shall file a response and any other information regarding this petition on or before May 17, 1999, with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, and send a copy to Sprint Communications Company, L.P.

2. That this order shall become effective on May 28, 1999.
