**ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF
ANNUAL REPORT**

On April 14, 2000, Teligent, Inc. (Teligent) filed an application requesting that portions of its annual report containing financial information, corporate organization detail, and subscription level and related data be treated as confidential because they contain market sensitive information that competitors could use to their economic advantage. Along with its Application, Teligent submitted both a confidential version and a public version of its annual report.

4 CSR 240-10.080(1) provides that "[a]ll public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year."

4 CSR 240-10.080(7) provides that the Commission may permit a utility to file confidential information contained in its annual report under seal, if the Commission finds that it has shown good cause to do so.

On June 27, the Staff of the Commission filed a Recommendation and Memorandum indicating that Teligent has shown good cause for granting

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its request for confidential treatment of certain information in its annual report. Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order granting Teligent's request for confidential treatment of a portion of page 3, and all of pages 5, 6, 7 and 8 of its 1999 annual report. Staff recommends that the specified information be allowed to remain confidential until April 15, 2001. After that date the information should be transferred to the public record unless Teligent shows that the information remains confidential. Staff further recommends that the Commission's record department be ordered to attach a copy of the order granting Teligent's request to the public version of the annual report.

After reviewing Teligent's motion and the Recommendation and Memorandum of Staff, the Commission concludes that Teligent's motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Teligent, Inc.'s request for confidential treatment of a portion of page 3, and all of pages 5, 6, 7 and 8 of its 1999 Annual Report is granted.

2. That the information recognized as confidential by this order shall be filed and maintained with this Commission under seal as a proprietary document pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080(7), until April 15, 2001. After that date the information shall be transferred to the public record unless Teligent, Inc. makes a further showing that the information remains confidential.

3. That the Records Department of the Public Service Commission shall attach a copy of this order to the public version of Teligent, Inc.'s 1999 Annual Report.

4. That this order shall become effective on July 20, 2000.

5. That this case may be closed on July 21, 2000.
