ORDER APPROVING TARIFF
AND CLOSING CASE

On December 21, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. (Central), authorizing it to construct, operate and maintain a public sewer system serving Wil Mar Estates Subdivision in Clay County, Missouri. In that Order, the Commission directed Central to file "within 60 days of the effective date of this order . . . appropriate amended tariff sheets . . . describing the terms and conditions under which it will provide sewer service in Clay County, Missouri." The Commission further directed the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) to file "a pleading in this case advising the Commission that the tariffs have been filed."

On February 10, 2000, Central filed its proposed amended tariff sheets. On March 1, 2000, Central filed substitute amended tariff sheets. On March 8, 2000, Staff filed its recommendation and memorandum, advising that Central had filed its amended tariff sheets, that they were in compliance with the Commission's Order of December 21, 1999, and that Staff

recommended that they be approved. On March 13, 2000, Central by letter advised that it was extending the effective date of its amended tariff to March 24, 2000.

The Commission has reviewed the amended tariff sheets and Staff's memorandum and recommendation, and finds that the tariff sheets, as amended on March 1, 2000, conform to the Commission's order of December 21, 1999, and should be approved to become effective on March 24, 2000.

For purposes of administrative efficiency, the Commission will close this case. However, Staff may still file the results of its rate review in this case even though it is closed. Other than Staff's rate review filing, no further activity will take place in this case, and it may now be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc., on February 10, 2000, and assigned tariff number 200000724, are approved as amended on March 1, 2000, for service rendered on and after March 24, 2000. The tariff sheets approved are:

2. That this order shall become effective on March 24, 2000.

3. That this case may be closed on March 25, 2000.
