ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT OUT OF TIME

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080(1), "[a]11 public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year."

On April 28, 2000, Timber Creek Sewer Company ("Timber Creek") filed a motion with the Commission requesting permission to file its 1999 annual report out of time. Timber Creek stated that it was unable to file its report timely due to inadvertent difficulties meeting the filing time. No objections to Timber Creek's motion were received.

The Commission finds that good cause exists to permit filing of Timber Creek's annual report out of time, and the Commission will grant Timber Creek's motion for leave to file its annual report out of time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Timber Creek Sewer Company's April 28, 2000, motion requesting permission to file its annual report out of time is granted, and the annual report deadline requirement of 4 CSR 240-10.080 is waived and the filing of Timber Creek Sewer Company's annual report on April 28, 2000, is approved.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on May 23, 2000.

3. That this case may be closed on May 30, 2000.
