ORDER DIRECTING COMPLIANCE

On February 22, 2000, the Commission issued an order that granted a certificate of service authority to Matrix Telecom, Inc. to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services. That order permitted Matrix Telecom, Inc. to continue to operate under a tariff originally approved for Matrix Telecom (a previously existing partnership) that it had adopted as its own. The order also directed Matrix Telecom, Inc. to file, no later than April 24, 2000, a revised tariff sheet conforming the waivers listed in the tariff with those granted in the order.

Matrix Telecom, Inc. has not yet complied with that portion of the Commission's order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Matrix Telecom, Inc. shall, no later than May 16, 2000, file a revised tariff sheet 1 conforming the waivers listed in the tariff with those granted in the Commission's order of February 22, 2000. 2. That Matrix Telecom, Inc. is advised that failure to comply with an order of the Commission may subject it to the penalties set forth at Sections 386.570 and 386.580, RSMo (1994).

3. That this order shall become effective on May 9, 2000.
