ORDER RESCHEDULING PROCEEDINGS
AND SETTING LOCAL HEARINGS

On January 16, 1987, intervenors Boatmen's, et al., filed a Motion requesting the Commission to schedule local public hearings in this matter. In support of their Motion intervenors state that intervenors represent only a small portion of KCPL's steam heat customers within the affected area and that local public hearings on the steam heat conversion plan would be beneficial to the Commission in terms of making its decision.

The Commission having reviewed the Motion concludes that it is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the Commission determines that a local public hearing will be scheduled as hereinafter ordered for the purpose of allowing those customers who have not intervened in this proceeding to testify with respect to KCPL's steam heat conversion plan. The Commission also determines that KCPL shall notify its steam heat customers of the public hearing scheduled in this matter.

On January 20, 1987, the Staff of the Commission filed its Motion For Extension Of Time requesting the Commission to extend the filing date, the date for the prehearing conference, the hearing memorandum and the hearing. On January 28, 1987, intervenors Boatmen, et al., filed a response to Staff's motion requesting that the filing dates be extended one week beyond those proposed by the Staff.

By letter dated January 28, 1987, the Hearing Examiner notified the parties that the date for the filing of direct testimony and schedules by Staff, Public Counsel and each intervenor was extended from February 2, 1987 to February 23, 1987. The letter stated that the Commission would reschedule the hearing by subsequent order.

Having reviewed the requests for extension of time by the Staff and Boatmen's, et al., the Commission determines that the schedule requested by Boatmen's, et al., is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That a local public hearing be, and it is, hereby scheduled for 2:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, in the Kansas City City Hall, 26th Floor, 414 East 12th Street, Kansas City, Missouri, on March 30, 1987.

ORDERED: 2. That Kansas City Power & Light Company shall notify its steam heat customers of the local public hearing herein scheduled on or before March 9, 1987.

ORDERED: 3. That the schedule of proceedings in this matter be, and it is, hereby rescheduled as set forth below:

Prehearing Conference 9:00 a.m., March 23 through March 27, 1987

Hearing Memorandum due 5:00 p.m., March 27, 1987.

Hearing 10:00 a.m., April 6 through April 17, 1987

ORDERED: 4. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
