ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION

On September 1, 2000, K-Powernet, L.L.C. (K-Powernet), filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and nonswitched local telecommunications services within the state of Missouri. On September 12, 2000, the Commission issued a Notice of Applicants, directing interested parties to intervene by September 27, 2000.

K-Powernet filed an amended application on September 13, 2000, which appears to be identical to the original application except for differences in the list of the waivers requested. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(21) provides that "[a]ny pleading may be amended within ten (10) days of filing, unless a responsive pleading has been filed, or at any time by leave of the commission." As K-Powernet filed its amended application on September 13, 2000, more than ten days after it filed the original application, the company is required to obtain Commission approval to file an amended application. The Commission will treat the filing of the amended application as a request for leave to file an amended application, and will allow

K-Powernet to amend its application. However, K-Powernet is directed to comply with the requirements in 4 CSR 240-2.080(21) in the future.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That K-Powernet, L.L.C., is granted leave to file its amended application as of September 13, 2000.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 12, 2000.

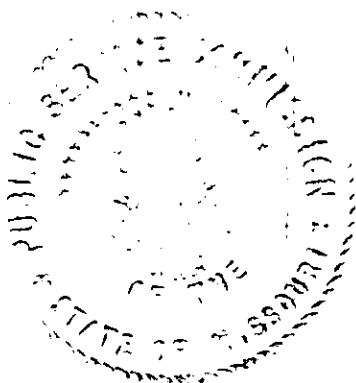
