ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On July 9, 2001, the Commission directed Applicant Primus Telecommunications, Inc., to file a status report on or before August 1, 2001. No status report has yet been filed.

The internal reorganization which is the subject of this matter was approved on May 11, 1999. Thereafter, on October 26, 1999, the Commission approved certain tariff revisions whereby Primus added the rates, services and regulations of TresCom USA, Inc., to its own tariffs. This action was intended to make the reorganization "seamless" as to TresCom's Missouri customers. The case was left open pending notification by the parties that the reorganization was finally complete. At that time, the Commission would cancel the tariffs of TresCom USA, Inc., and close this case. However, that notification has never been received.

The Commission will direct its Staff to ascertain the status of this matter and report back to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file, on or before October 1, 2001, a status report with respect to the final completion of the

reorganization previously approved in this case. The Staff shall also advise the Commission whether either Primus Telecommunications, Inc., or TresCom USA, Inc., is actually providing telecommunications services in Missouri and whether any action should be pursued with respect to the failure of Primus Telecommunications, Inc., to obey an order of this Commission.

2. That this Order shall become effective on September 1, 2001.
