

ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO REPORT

On July 3, 2000, the Commission issued an order entitled Order Revising Date for Submission of Proposed Procedural Schedule. That order directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than July 31. The parties failed to comply with that order in that they did not file either a proposed procedural schedule, or a request for extension of time. On August 29, the Commission issued an order that directed the parties to comply with the Commission's July 3rd order.

On September 8, Union Electric Company (UE) filed a response to the Commission's order directing compliance. UE indicated its belief that the complaint will be resolved informally without the need for additional proceedings, and requested that this matter be passed until October 10. By that date, the parties will either inform the Commission that the matter has been resolved and request that the Complaint be dismissed, or that some additional time will be required before a dismissal may be requested. In any event, UE indicates that the parties will report back to the Commission by October 10.

UE's Response satisfies the Commission's order of August 29. The Commission will allow the parties additional time to informally resolve this complaint. The Commission wishes to remain informed about the progress of this case and will direct the parties to report on the status of the case by October 10.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That no later than October 10, 2000, the parties shall file a report indicating the status of this case.
2. That this order shall become effective on September 28, 2000.
