## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE MEMORANDUM ON STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

On March 29, 2000, the Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff), the Office of the Public Counsel, Atmos Energy Corporation, Arkansas Western Gas Company, d/b/b Associated Natural Gas Company, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 1439 and Noranda Aluminum, Inc., filed a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (the Agreement).

The Agreement states that, if requested by the Commission, the Staff shall have the right to submit to the Commission a memorandum explaining its rationale for entering into the Agreement. The Agreement further provides that each party of record shall be served with a copy of the memorandum and shall have the right to submit to the Commission, within five (5) days of the receipt of Staff's



memorandum, a responsive memorandum that shall also be served on all parties. The Agreement states that all memoranda submitted by the parties pursuant to this provision shall be considered privileged in the same manner as are settlement discussions under the Commission's rules, shall be maintained on a confidential basis by all parties, and shall not become a part of the record of this proceeding or bind or prejudice the party submitting such memorandum in this or any future proceeding, whether or not the Commission approves the Agreement. The Agreement states that the contents of any memorandum provided by any party are its own and are not acquiesced in or otherwise adopted by the other signatories to the Agreement, whether or not the Commission approves the Agreement.

The Commission would like to have additional information about this Agreement and will request a memorandum from the Staff as provided in the Agreement.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall furnish a memorandum explaining its rationale for entering into the proposed Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
- 2. That Staff's memorandum shall be submitted no later than 3:00 p.m. on April 11, 2000.
- 3. That the other parties shall be allowed until 3:00 p.m. on April 17, 2000 to submit any response they wish to make to Staff's memorandum.

4. That this order shall become effective on April 14, 2000.
