**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On March 6, 2000, the Commission adopted the procedural schedule proposed by the parties. On May 12, ALLTEL Missouri, Inc., Missouri Independent Telephone Group, Small Telephone Company Group, and Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule. The movants state that they agreed to a settlement at the prehearing conference, and request that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule indefinitely to allow them to finalize the agreement. Movants state that all parties either join in the motion or do not oppose it. The request is reasonable and the Commission will suspend the procedural schedule.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the procedural schedule is suspended.

2. That this order shall become effective on May 26, 2000.
