ORDER DIRECTING STAFF INVESTIGATION

The September 13, 1999, issue of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners Bulletin lists a number of utilities that reported to the North American Electric Reliability Council that they were not yet Y2K-ready. Two Missouri utilities appear on the list: Central Missouri Electric Cooperative and the City of Mansfield. The Commission will direct its Staff to investigate the current status of the efforts of these two utilities to become Y2K-ready, as well as their plans to become Y2K-ready. The Commission will also direct Staff to file a report detailing the results of its investigation and recommending what action, if any, the Commission should take.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall investigate and report on the year 2000 readiness of the Central Missouri Electric Cooperative

and the City of Mansfield no later than October 21, 1999, as discussed herein.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 15, 1999.
