**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO  
FILE RESPONSE**

On February 8, 1999, the Respondent, City of Park Hills, filed a Motion for Reconsideration of Order Denying Respondent's Motion to Dismiss. 4 CSR 240-2.080(12) provides that parties are allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any motion or other pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. On February 17, the Complainants, City of Desloge and City of Leadington, filed a Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Response to Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration. By that motion, Desloge and Leadington request that they be allowed until March 1 to file a written response to Park Hills' motion.

The Commission has determined that the request for extension of time to file a response should be granted.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**
