ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On April 15, 1999, the Commission by order granted the application of Raytown Water Company (Applicant or Raytown) for authority to issue Missouri Environmental Improvement and Energy Resources Authority (EIERA) exempt facility refunding revenue bonds, in the principal amount of \$2,470,000, and taxable water facilities revenue bonds, in the principal amount of \$200,000. That order required "[t]hat Raytown Water Company shall submit all pertinent information to the Staff of the Commission within 10 days of completion of the above transaction, and shall file a pleading in this case notifying the Commission and the parties that the information has been submitted to the Staff of the Commission." As of today, Raytown has filed nothing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Raytown Water Company shall, within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order, file pleading stating the current status of the financing transaction previously approved and advising the Commission when Raytown Water Company expects to make filings in compliance with the Commission's order of April 15, 1999.

2. That this Order shall become effective on August 13, 1999.
