ORDER APPROVING INTERIM RATES

Missouri Gas Energy (MGE or Company), a division of Southern Union Company, of Kansas City, Missouri, submitted a tariff sheet to the Commission on October 17, 1997, carrying an effective date of November 1, 1997. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect scheduled changes in MGE's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as the result of changes in the cost of natural gas for the upcoming winter season. Additionally the Transition Cost factor will decrease. Although the net effect of these changes will increase the current PGA factors, the net effect of these changes will decrease the 1997-1998 winter season revenues by approximately \$11.3 million as compared to the 1996-1997 winter season revenues. The winter season includes the months of November through March. The impact on a typical residential space heating customer using 88.8 Mcf of natural gas in the winter season will be a decrease of \$12.62, or 2.0%.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum stating that the change in MGE's PGA was calculated in conformance with the Company's approved PGA Clause and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective on November 1, 1997. Staff stated that MGE's PGA Clause allows for ten (10) business days notice for filings reflecting PGA changes. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective November 1, 1997 on an interim basis, subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in MGE's ACA Cases No. GR-96-450 and GR-98-167.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheet conforms to the Company's Commission approved PGA Clause and is therefore reasonable. After considering Staff's recommendation, and for good cause shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo 1994, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be approved to become effective on and after the requested effective date of November 1, 1997, interim subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet submitted on October 17, 1997, by Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, of Kansas City, Missouri, is approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, to become effective on November 1, 1997. The tariff sheet approved is:

XI ADJUSTMENT STATEMENT

For billings on and after August 15, 1997, any increase or decrease in the PGA/EGCIM rate shall be applied to customers' bills for service rendered on and after the effective date of the change. The PGA/EGCIM rate effective immediately prior to August 15, 1997, shall be applied to customers' bills for service rendered prior to August 15, 1997. Bills computed which contain multiple PGA/EGCIM rate changes during a customer's billing cycle shall be prorated between the old and new rates in proportion to the number of days in the customer's billing cycle that such rates were in effect.
