ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On May 26, 1999, the Commission approved an interconnection agreement under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act) between Midwestern Services L.C., doing business as Midwestern Tel (Midwestern), and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT). That order directed Midwestern to "file a copy of this agreement with the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, with the pages numbered seriatim in the lower right-hand corner no later than June 15, 1999. Midwestern . . . shall file on the same date a notice in the official case file advising the Commission that the agreement has been submitted to Staff as required."

Midwestern has not complied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Midwestern Services L.C., doing business as Midwestern Tel, shall, within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order, file a copy of the interconnection agreement with the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, with the pages numbered seriatim in the lower right-hand corner, and, on the same

day, file a notice in the official case file advising the Commission that the agreement has been submitted to Staff as required.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 2, 1999.
