
MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of MAWC’s tariff sheets filed on December 28, 2017:

1. MAWC intends to close the transaction that is the subject of the Commission’s *Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* on January 8, 2018.
2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, MAWC has filed sewer tariff sheets consistent with the Commission’s *Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity*. These tariff sheets carry proposed effective dates of January 27, 2018 (30 days), and have been assigned Tracking No. YS-2018-0079. A list of the filed tariff sheets is attached hereto as **Appendix A.**
3. MAWC hereby seeks the Commission’s order allowing the proposed tariff sheets to go into effect on less than thirty days notice.
4. A grant of this motion will further the public interest. The subject transaction will be closed on January 8, 2018. As of that date, MAWC will own and operate the subject system. The subject tariff sheets are intended to clarify the rates, rules and regulations that will apply to the subject customers on a going-forward basis. Addressing these tariff sheets in an expedited manner will eliminate or reduce any gap that might exist in regard to these subjects.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, MAWC respectfully requests the Commission grant this Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve MAWC's proposed tariff sheets identified by Tracking No. YS-2018-0079, to be effective on January 8, 2018, or as soon thereafter as the Commission has the opportunity to address this matter.
