("SNGMO"); for itself and on behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission; the Office of the Public Counsel; Missouri School Boards' Association; Missouri Propane Gas Association; and, Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy; (collectively the "Parties"), and respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission").

- 1. The procedural schedule in this case currently calls for surrebuttal testimony to be filed on August 6, 2014.
