### ORDER APPROVING THIRD-YEAR PHASE IN TARIFFS

)

By its Order on April 1, 1987, this Commission authorized Kansas City Power & Light Company to file tariffs reflecting the phase-in plan authorized in that April 1, 1987 Order in Case Nos. E0-85-185, E0-85-224 and A0-87-48.

On April 6, 1987, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted new tariff sheets reflecting the increase for each of the remaining years of the phase-in plan. The third year phase-in increase is 2.21%. In response to the Commission's November 23, 1987 Order Approving Joint Recommendation issued in Case Nos. E0-85-185 and E0-85-224, Kansas City Power & Light Company on December 8, 1987, filed a letter with the Commission withdrawing the tariff sheets previously filed with proposed effective dates after May 5, 1988. The withdrawn tariff sheets were to have taken effect in the years 1989-1994.

On March 29, 1988 Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted a revised Special Contract Rate Schedule pursuant to the Power Supply Agreement with Armco Inc. and the Rate Design Stipulation in Case Nos. E0-85-185 and E0-85-224. The current Special Contract Rate Schedule was approved by the Commission by Electric Authority Order No. 969 on September 9, 1987.

The Staff has reviewed the proposed tariffs for the third year phase-in and recommends approval.

The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed third year phase-in tariffs submitted April 6, 1987 and the Special Contract Rate Schedule for Armco Inc. submitted March 29, 1988, comply with its Orders issued April 1, 1987, November 23, 1987, and September 9, 1987, and said tariff sheets should be allowed to become effective for electric service rendered on and after May 5, 1988.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the following third year phase-in tariff sheets submitted April 6, 1987, and the Special Contract Rate Schedule submitted March 29, 1988 by Kansas City Power & Light Company of Kansas City, Missouri, for the purpose of increasing rates for electric service provided to customers in its Missouri service area be, and they are, hereby approved and made effective for electric service rendered on and after May 5, 1988.
