ORDER DIRECTING FILING

That Camarato Distributing, Inc., shall, on or before September 20, 1999, file a supplement to its Application containing the street and mailing address of its principal place of business and a brief statement of the character of the business performed by it, all as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1), (A) and (B). As required

by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(F), the supplement shall be verified.

2. That this Order shall become effective on September 13, 1999.
