ORDER SCHEDULING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS

On December 17, 1999, the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc. (NANPA), filed a petition requesting that the Commission approve a "retroactive" all services overlay relief plan for the 314 Numbering Plan Area (NPA) (affecting the 636 NPA) and a single all services overlay relief plan for the 816 NPA.

The Commission established a procedural schedule in this case in an order issued on March 1, 2000, and subsequently modified that schedule pursuant to a request of the parties in an order issued on March 20, 2000. The case is set for evidentiary hearing on July 31, 2000, through August 3, 2000, at the Commission's office located in Jefferson City. The procedural schedule provides a time frame for conducting local public hearings. Commission will conduct local public hearings before the evidentiary hearing.

The Commission will direct its Information Officer to send notice of the local public hearings to radio stations, television stations, and publishers of newspapers located in the St. Louis area the Kansas City and other areas served by the 314/636 and 816 area codes respectively. The information officer may utilize the newspaper

directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri.

The Information Office shall also provide notice to members of the General Assembly in the areas served by these area codes.

The Commission will also direct the Records Department of the Commission to serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within these areas. The Records Department will serve all parties of record as is customary in Commission proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That a local public hearing shall be held on Monday, April 24, 2000, in the Hickey Room, at Harris-Stow State College, 3026 Laclede, St. Louis, Missouri, commencing at 12:30 p.m. and continuing until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 2:30 p.m.
- 2. That a local public hearing shall be held on Monday, April 24, 2000, in the Conference Room, at the Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission, 815 Charter Commons Drive, Suite 100B, Chesterfield, Missouri, commencing at 6:30 p.m. and continuing until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 8:30 p.m.
- 3. That a local public hearing shall be held on Monday, April 24, 2000, in the Multipurpose Room, at the O'Fallon Municipal Center, 100 North Main Street, O'Fallon, Missouri, commencing at 6:30 p.m. and continuing until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 8:30 p.m.
- 4. That a local public hearing shall be held on Wednesday, May 3, 2000, in the Legislative Assembly Area, Room 204, at the

Jackson County Courthouse, 415 East 12th Street, Kansas City, Missouri, commencing at 12:30 p.m. and continuing until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 2:30 p.m.

- 5. That a local public hearing shall be held on Wednesday, May 3, 2000, in the Council Chambers, at the St. Joseph City Hall, 11th & Frederick, St Joseph, Missouri, commencing at 6:30 p.m. and continuing until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 8:30 p.m.
- 6. That a local public hearing shall be held on Wednesday, May 3, 2000, in Fleming Hall, at the Jackson County Park Facility in Blue Springs, 21906 Woods Chapel Road, Blue Springs, Missouri, commencing at 6:30 p.m. and continuing until all persons present have had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 8:30 p.m.
- 7. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall be available at the locations as stated in paragraphs 1 through 6 above, one hour prior to the hearing, in order to answer questions from members of the public. At that time, other parties to this case may attend and make a brief informational presentation or answer questions or both.
- 8. That the Records Department of the Commission, in addition to serving all parties, shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within the St. Louis and Kansas City areas and the areas served by the 314/636 and 816 area codes.
- 9. That the Information Office of the Commission shall serve copies of this order and provide notice as described in this order.
