ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING OF RECOMMENDATION

On September 15, 1999, Ellington Telephone Company (Ellington) submitted a tariff designed to offer a Digital Channel Service (DCS) that will be available to internet service providers. The tariff bears an effective date of October 15. Along with its tariff, Ellington filed a Motion for Expedited Approval. That motion indicates that Ellington has two customers waiting to purchase the DCS services and requests that the Commission approve Ellington's DCS tariff to be effective on October 1, 1999, or as soon after that date as possible. Ellington's Motion for Expedited Approval states good cause for such treatment as required by 4 CSR 240-2.065(2).

In order that the Commission may consider Ellington's tariff expeditiously, the Staff of the Public Service Commission will be directed to expedite the filing of its recommendations regarding Ellington's tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file its recommendations regarding the tariff of Ellington Telephone Company (Tariff File No. 200000237) no later than September 28, 1999.
2. That this order shall become effective on September 28, 1999.
