

ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On August 10, 1999, Teligent, Inc. (Teligent), and Teligent Services, Inc. (TSI), filed a joint application for approval of the transfer of Teligent's certificates of authority to TSI. Regulation 4 CSR 240-2.060(5)(G) requires that all applications for assignment or transfer of assets include "a statement of the impact, if any, the sale, assignment, lease or transfer of assets will have on the tax revenues of the political subdivisions in which any structures, facilities or equipment of the companies involved in the sale are located." In addition, 4 CSR 240-2.060(5)(H) requires that the applicants state "whether the purchaser has any pending or final judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency which involve customer service or rates." Applicants have not included either of these statements.

No further action will be taken by the Commission on this application until the applicants come into compliance with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.060(5)(G) and (5)(H).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Teligent Inc., and Teligent Services Inc., shall, within ten (10) days of the effective date of this order, file a supplement to their application containing a statement of the impact, if any, the transfer will have on the tax revenues as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(5)(G).

2. That Teligent, Inc., and Teligent Services, Inc., shall, within ten (10) days of the effective date of this order, file a supplement to their application containing a statement of its pending or final judgments or decisions involving customer service or rates as required by 4 CSR 240-2.060(5)(H).

3. That this order shall become effective on August 31, 1999.
