ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO PREPARE REPORT AND PARTICIPATE
IN PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On May 1, 2000, Louie S. Andrews and Amy R. Andrews filed a complaint against Union Electric Company (AmerenUE). AmerenUE filed its response to the complaint on June 2. On June 7, the Commission issued an order that scheduled a prehearing conference for June 30 and directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than July 7.

Both the complaint and AmerenUE's response indicate that the Staff of the Commission has already had some involvement in attempting to resolve the dispute between the complainants and AmerenUE. Staff's further involvement in this case would be helpful.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Staff is directed to prepare a brief report detailing its involvement in the dispute between Louie S. Andrews and Amy R. Andrews and Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. The Staff shall present its

report to the Commission and to the other parties at the prehearing conference on June 30, 2000.

2. That Staff shall participate in the prehearing conference on June 30, 2000.

3. That this order shall become effective on June 30, 2000.
