ORDER EXTENDING DATE FOR FILING A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 20, 1999, the Commission issued an order in which it required the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 19, 1999. On October 19, 1999, the parties filed a pleading in which they requested that the Commission suspend the deadline for filing a proposed procedural schedule to allow them time to finish drafting a stipulation and agreement. The parties state that they expect to be able to file a stipulation and agreement by November 2, 1999. The Commission will not indefinitely suspend the requirement to file a proposed procedural schedule as the parties appear to request, but will instead extend the deadline for filing it.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than November 30, 1999.

2. That this order shall become effective on November 1, 1999.
