RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) and, in response to the Staff Recommendation, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

1. On December 18, 2018, MAWC filed an application requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system in the Timber Springs Estates subdivision in Clinton County, Missouri.

2. On February 11, 2019, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Staff Recommendation and an associated Memorandum, wherein it recommended approval of the Application with conditions described in the Memorandum. The Memorandum identifies recommendations 1-16. (Memo, p. 6-7)

3. MAWC has no objection to recommendations 1-16.

WHEREFORE, Missouri-American Water Company prays the Commission consider this Response to Staff Recommendation and, thereafter, issue its order granting MAWC’s
