ORDER OF DEFAULT

David A. Turner and Michele R. Turner filed a formal complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on February 2, 2000, against Warren County Water and Sewer Co., Inc. (Respondent). On February 15, 2000, the Commission issued a Notice of Complaint to the Respondent by certified mail requiring the Respondent to answer by March 16, 2000.

Pursuant to Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.070(9), if the respondent in a complaint case fails to file an answer within the time period allowed, the respondent is in default and the allegations of the complaint are deemed admitted by the respondent. Respondent failed to file an answer within thirty days of notice being issued. The Commission finds that the Respondent is in default and the allegations in the complaint are deemed admitted by the Respondent.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Respondent is in default and that all allegations set forth in the complaint are deemed admitted.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 11, 2000.
