ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On July 15, 1999, Fiber Four Corporation d/b/a Holway Long Distance (Holway) filed its application for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and local exchange telecommunication services. Holway also filed a Motion to Expedite Application and Tariff Approval or To Grant Interim Authority and Approval. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its response to Holway's Motion to Expedite indicating that Staff recommends rejecting an interim tariff. Staff also states that it agreed that the circumstances stated warrant expediting review and indicates it will file its recommendation on Holway's application and tariff on or before July 30, 1999.

The Commission has reviewed the pleadings filed and finds that because of the circumstances stated, there exists good cause to expedite consideration of the certificate and tariffs in this case. Section 392.430, RSMo. 1994, requires notice to be given before a certificate of service authority for local exchange and interexchange telecommunication services may be approved by the Commission. Notice was issued July 27, 1999, and parties have until August 11, 1999 to file their application for intervention. The Commission may grant a

"temporary certificate . . . without notice and hearing, pending the determination of an application for a certificate." Section 392.410.6, RSMo (Cum. Supp. 1998). In order for the Commission to issue a temporary certificate in an expeditious manner, the Commission finds it necessary to receive Staff's recommendation concerning Holway's application for certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services and its proposed tariffs before 4 p.m. on July 28, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission is directed to file its recommendation concerning the application for certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services and the proposed tariffs with the Commission no later than 4 p.m. on July 28, 1999.
2. That this order shall become effective on July 28, 1999.
