**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO
FILE RESPONSE**

On February 9, 1999, the Complainants, City of Desloge and City of Leadington, filed a Motion to Temporarily Suspend Water Charges and Collection in Excess of those Rates Charged Within Park Hills. 4 CSR 240-2.080(12) provides that parties are allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any motion or other pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. On February 19, the Respondent, City of Park Hills, filed a Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Response to Motion of Cities of Desloge and Leadington to Temporarily Suspend Water Charges and Collection in Excess of Those Rates Charged within Park Hills. By that motion, Park Hills requests that it be allowed until ten days after the Commission rules upon Park Hills' Motion for Reconsideration of Order Denying Respondent's Motion to Dismiss to file a written response to Desloge and Leadington's motion.

The Commission has determined that the request for extension of time to file a response should be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Response to Motion of Cities of Desloge and Leadington to Temporarily Suspend Water Charges and Collection in Excess of Those Rates Charged within Park Hills, filed by the City of Park Hills, is granted.

2. That the City of Park Hills shall file its response to the Motion of Cities of Desloge and Leadington to Temporarily Suspend Water Charges and Collection in Excess of Those Rates Charged within Park Hills, no later than ten days after the issue date of the Commission's ruling upon Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration of Order Denying Respondent's Motion to Dismiss.

3. That this order shall become effective on March 8, 1999.
