**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

On October 15, 1999, McDonald County Long Distance Company (McDonald County) filed proposed revisions to its P.S.C. Mo. No. 1 Tariff. The tariff revisions indicate an effective date of November 14, 1999, and are designed to add service descriptions and rates for toll directory assistance, which were inadvertently omitted from the original tariff filing. As the tariff is currently written, McDonald County will not be able to bill its customers and recover its costs for toll directory assistance. McDonald County will begin providing the service on October 20, and requested that the Commission expedite its consideration of the tariff.

On October 19, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff to Expedite Consideration of Tariff. Staff filed a memorandum on October 20, indicating that Staff has reviewed the tariff sheets submitted by McDonald County and recommends that the Commission approve them as submitted, to become effective as soon as possible.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on October 22, 1999.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the tariff sheets filed by McDonald County Long Distance Company, on October 15, 1999, and assigned tariff number 200000361, are approved to become effective on October 22, 1999. The tariff sheets approved are:

McDonald County Long Distance Company P.S.C. Mo. No. 1  
1st Revised Sheet No. 38, Cancels Original Sheet No. 38  
1st Revised Sheet No. 46, Cancels Original Sheet No. 46  
1st Revised Sheet No. 47, Cancels Original Sheet No. 47

2. That this order shall become effective on October 22, 1999.
3. That this case may be closed on October 25, 1999.
