ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On October 15, 1999, Ellington Telephone Company, d/b/a McCormack - Missouri (Ellington) filed proposed revisions to its P.S.C. Mo. No. 1 Tariff. The tariff revisions indicate an effective date of November 14, 1999, and are designed to add service descriptions and rates for toll directory assistance, which were inadvertently omitted from the original tariff filing. As the tariff is currently written, Ellington will not be able to bill its customers and recover its costs for toll directory assistance. Ellington will begin providing the service on October 20, and requested that the Commission expedite its consideration of the tariff.

On October 20, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff to Expedite Consideration of Tariff. On October 20 and again on October 21, Ellington filed substitute tariff sheets to correct typographical errors. Staff filed a memorandum on October 25, indicating that Staff has reviewed the tariff sheets submitted by Ellington and recommends that the Commission approve them as amended, to become effective as soon as possible.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on October 26, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Ellington Telephone Company, d/b/a McCormack-Missouri, on October 15, 1999, and assigned tariff number 200000369, are approved to become effective on October 26, 1999. The tariff sheets approved are:
