

**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On June 14, 2000, Spectra Communications Group, LLC (Spectra), filed an application to be designated as an eligible carrier to receive Universal Service Fund support pursuant to Section 254 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K) requires that applications include:

"A statement indicating whether the applicant has any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the application."

In addition, Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(L) requires that applications state that "no annual report or assessment fees are overdue." Neither of these statements was included in Spectra's application.

Therefore, Spectra will be ordered to file an amended pleading or an exhibit in compliance with these Commission rules.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Spectra Communications Group, LLC, shall file on or before July 10, 2000, an amended pleading or an exhibit in compliance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K) and (L).

2. That this order shall become effective on June 29, 2000.


