ORDER DENYING REHEARING

On October 12, 1994, the Commission issued a Report and Order in this case approving an \$800,0000 increase in St. Joseph Light & Power Company's (SJLP) annual steam revenues. On October 21, 1994, AG Processing, Inc. (AGP) filed a motion for rehearing. AGP argues that the Commission's October 12, 1994 Report and Order is unjust, unlawful, arbitrary, unreasonable, unauthorized by law, and unsupported by competent and substantial evidence.

On October 26, 1994, the Commission issued an Order Regarding Motion To Correct amending its Report and Order to authorize SJLP to file revised tariff sheets. On October 27, 1994, AGP filed a supplement to its motion for rehearing requesting a rehearing of the Order Regarding Motion To Correct. AGP argues that the revised tariff sheets will produce revenues in excess of the tariff sheets which initiated this case and that the Commission acted arbitrarily, unreasonably, unlawfully, and in excess of its power and authority.

Pursuant to Section 386.500, RSMo 1986, the Commission shall grant a rehearing "if in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Upon review of AGP's motions, the Commission finds that there

is not sufficient reason to order a rehearing of its Report and Order in this case. Likewise, the Commission finds that there is not sufficient reason to order a rehearing of its Order Regarding Motion To Correct. Thus, the Commission determines that AGP's motions for rehearing should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the motion for rehearing of the Report and Order in this case filed by AG Processing, Inc. is hereby denied.
- 2. That the motion for rehearing of the Order Regarding Motion
 To Correct in this case filed by AG Processing, Inc. is hereby denied.
 - 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
