## ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE

On February 25, 1994, the Commission issued an Order Approving Financing in the above-referenced case. Ordered Paragraph No. 2 of that order stated:

That the Choctaw Telephone Company shall file the final terms and conditions of the financing not later than thirty (30) days after all of the final documentation has been completed.

As of this date, no such documentation has been received by the Commission.

If this financing has not been undertaken by Choctaw Telephone Company, the Commission should be so notified. If the financing has been completed, the documentation is, again, ordered to be filed with the Commission as set out above. If the financing was completed more than thirty (30) days ago, then Choctaw is additionally ordered to show cause for its failure to comply with the Commission order as required by §386.570, RSMo 1994.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Choctaw Telephone Company shall either comply with ordered Paragraph No. 2 of the Commission's Order Approving Financing as issued on February 25, 1994 or, in the alternative, show cause why compliance is not appropriate.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
