ORDER DIRECTING THE FILING OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This case is on remand to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) from the Circuit Court of Cole County. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) originally proposed a \$1,200,000 disallowance on the issue of UtiliCorp costs. The Commission finds that it cannot adequately review this issue without a further breakdown of the disallowance amount. Thus, the Commission will direct the parties to file a breakdown of Staff's proposed \$1,200,000 disallowance by Responsibility Center. In addition, the disallowance breakdown by Responsibility Center should also separately indicate what portion of a disallowance for a Responsibility Center represents Staff's allocation of labor costs to that Responsibility Center, and what portion represents Staff's allocation of overhead costs to that Responsibility Center.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the parties shall file with the Missouri Public Service Commission a document which breaks down Staff's originally proposed disallowance of \$1,200,000 of UtiliCorp costs by Responsibility Centers, as directed in this Order. The filing shall be made by April 25, 1996.
